IMPORTANT Guidelines & Procedures

- → Arrive no more than 15 minutes early to rehearsal unless otherwise specified.
- → Students should be dropped off near the South entrance to the football stadium, and be picked up in the same location. Please stay in line in your vehicle and wait for your student to come to you after rehearsal.
- → Viking Band Drum Majors and Staff will be near all entrances to help students find where they need to be.
- → Students should maintain social distancing of 6' at all times. Groups of students should NOT intermingle with other
- → Wearing a mask is appropriate. All Staff and Drum Majors will wear masks.
- → Bring your own water bottle. No sharing. There will not be water refill stations available, so plan accordingly.
- → Wear athletic shorts, t-shirt, and good supportive tennis shoes. It will be hot and you will be outside at times on your feet. Plan accordingly (sunscreen suggested)!

- → Practice good personal hygiene (wash your hands and use hand sanitizer).
- → Students feeling ill should NOT attend and contact their health provider. Contact a director to let them know why you are not in attendance.
